A big "Praise the Lord" development is we are building a runway and a hangar on our property. The mission plane will be housed here and the hangar will serve maintenance needs. We have a lot of work to do before the snow flies on both the hangar and the runway but it is happening! At this time we have

\$125,000. as a low interest loan for 4 years and a love gift of \$50,000. to pay for the hangar. We stand amazed at the Lord's faithfulness. Our pioneering hearts are beating fast and it's exciting to think about how the Lord will use us in relationships with missions and the aircraft to do His work!

Whether that be vehicle maintenance, building repairs for the Bible camps or boiler repair. Maintenance is a huge challenge especially when it is -30 degrees.

Barb continues to work with women behind prison bars through Kairos International. She is preparing for the 4 day Fall retreat for the inmates during the first weekend in November. The Lord uses the retreat to set the ladies free for eternity, even though they are in prison. God is doing great things in the lives of the ladies. Many have never experienced unconditional love. Please pray for the ladies as they are released. There are lots of temptations to go back to the old life style, often with drugs.

Faith Community nursing is also a blessing as Barb builds relationship with people in need. Health is much more than just our physical bodies, our emotions and our spirit also needs to be healed and ministered to. Like our friend Steve, who fought the battle with cancer and then went to be with the Lord this past June.

Being open to "divine appointments" is one way to touch people for Jesus. Here's one example; There was a lady taking pictures of our house. I asked her what she was doing? She said my husband and I are traveling around Alaska, I like your little house in the mountains. Berra is from Turkey, she told me they stayed in churches a lot and that people were very kind to them. I asked her if she was a follower of Jesus? She said no I'm not religious but I do believe in one Creator but many "messengers" like Jesus and Mohammed etc. Different messengers but the same God. I told her but Jesus was very different from the rest. He died to pay for our sins and then He arose. Who of the other messengers did that? She said you have a good point.
