### Suggestions for family devotions

- ◇ **Sunday:** Read Revelation 2:8-11. What does God call us to do when things are hard?
- ◇ **Monday:** Read 1 Peter 5:1-11. Ask God to help with all that worries you.
- ◇ **Tuesday:** Read Romans 8:31-36. Can anything we face separate us from the love of God?
- ◇ **Wednesday:** Read Isaiah 43:1-5. Who will be with us when things are hard?
- ◇ **Thursday:** Read 2 Corinthians 4:7-10 (or 18). Will hard things ever be more than God can handle?
- ◇ **Friday:** Read Psalm 23. Who comforts us in hard times?
- ◇ **Saturday:** Read Revelation 21:1-4. What will happen to suffering when Jesus returns?
